## Preliminary Operating Statistics For the 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter 2017



In the second quarter 2017, Thai AirAsia ("TAA") recorded load factor of 86%, up by 3 percentage points(ppts) YoY. The total number of passengers carried during the quarter were 4.69 million, increased by 13% YoY, which is higher than 9% growth in seat capacity. Moreover, TAA took an additional aircraft in this quarter and TAA has added 5 aircraft compared with the same period last year, allowing them to end the quarter with a total of 54 aircraft.
